

PHS Community Service Program

Who receives recognition?

Students who perform at least 50 hours of community service in a year will receive recognition. Hours can start being accumulated for the upcoming school year immediately following the end of the current school year.

Each student completing the required hours will receive a certificate at the All School Awards Assembly held in May. Those students completing 50 hours per year for all four years of high school will receive an honors cord for graduation. Documentation must be turned in each year school year.

What counts as community service?

Hours must be contributed to non-profit organizations, community care facilities or individuals not directly related to the student. No pay or credit toward high school graduation is permitted. Hours must be performed outside of the school day. (*Example activities that are not allowed: Band credit-related, Paid Babysitting, managing a sport, club meeting hours.*)

How are hours tracked?

Students who complete community service hours must have a form signed by the *individual supervising* the activity. The signed form is then turned into the high school office each May and recorded in a database.
